## Copyright statement

### Copyrighted material and peer-to-peer file sharing

Everyone's SMART University respects intellectual property rights, including rights in copyrighted materials for, its students, faculty, and third parties. All University has implemented a comprehensive policy to help protect these rights and comply with the copyright law of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the peer-to-peer file sharing provisions of the Higher Education Law. Strict compliance with University policies is required of all students and staff of the university. University policies are reviewed annually to determine their effectiveness.

### Copyright Law

Under the copyright protection system, the author of a creative work automatically owns the copyright to that work when done. The author is a person who has published the work attributed to him, whether by mentioning his name on the work, or by any other method, the author can transfer the copyright ownership to another person so that the copyright owner is not the original author of the work. Ownership of copyright grants the owner exclusive rights to this work, such as the right to display, reproduce, transmit, create derivative works from, publicly perform, distribute, and license the creative work. This means that if you do not obtain permission from the author, you may not take someone else's creative work and exercise these rights. This infringement is called "infringement" of the owner's copyrights. For example, if you legally purchased an e-book, you may not create copies of the book and distribute those copies to others over the internet. It may also

be illegal to help others infringe the owner's copyright by facilitating the distribution of such material.

### **Procedures and penalties for copyright infringement**

Under Saudi copyright law, the copyright owner who is a victim of copyright infringement has the right to recover damages and actual profits from the infringer or legal damages of up to two hundred and fifty thousand Riyals for each violation. The copyright owner has the right to permanently prevent the infringer from engaging in further infringing activities.

EVERYONE'S SMART University, which recognizes and respects intellectual property rights, requires its employees, teachers, students and other community members to use copyrighted material in a lawful manner. Everyone's Smart University offers behavior's basis, as found in the Everyone's SMART University Student Manual (<https://esu.edu.sa/index.php/en/study-system/>), Everyone's Smart University Copyright Policy. Copyright infringement can lead to refusing applicants, admission, and dismissal of students and registered staff.

In addition, the University maintains a strong approach in accepting and responding to digital material copyright notices, which are promptly escalated to Everyone University's legal team for investigation and action. If the legal department determines that the material in question is infringing, the IT department is notified and action is taken which can include either removing the infringing material from the university's network or blocking access to the violator's network. The offender is notified and reminded of the Everyone University Code of Conduct. Repeated violations can lead to dismissal.
